The Tango Society of Boston—Nito & Elba (cont'd)

About Nito and Elba

<u>Nito</u> was raised in Avellaneda, a town in Argentina renowned for tango, where he began learning to dance in 1953. The authenticity and skill of Nito's dancing <u>won him 15 competitions between 1955 and 1965</u>. The following year, Nito went on to star as the <u>principal dancer with Osvaldo Pugliese's orchestra</u> in the tango show "Cielo de Barrilete" at the Marconi Theater and Dado Rojo. In 1977, Nito began dancing with <u>Elba</u>, whose elegance and precision complement Nito's refined yet dramatic style. Since 1990 they have been dancing and teaching internationally in Mexico, the United States and Europe. Nito and Elba won the prestigious Lobo del Mar award in 1996 for their outstanding contribution to the arts and was presented with the "Person of the City" award in Mar del Plata for 1997. They are always in high demand as guest teachers at the most prestigious Tango Congresses in the world, including <u>CITA-2000</u>, <u>CITA-2001</u> and <u>CITA-2002</u> in <u>Buenos Aires</u>.

Brand new to Tango.	Take the Fundamentals: T1 and T2 . If you feel comfortable with these, add T3 and T4 .		
Advanced Beginner: Have done some Tango before and can dance Tango comfortably around the room.	Take all Saturday's workshops: T1-T4 . Do not skip any of the early workshops!		
Intermediate dancer: Can dance giros comfortably and incorporate them naturally into your dancing.	Take all weekend workshops T1-T8 and S1-S2 and benefit from the Weekend Pass or SuperPass pricing. (The Saturday classes are very important even for experienced dancers.)		
Advanced dancer: Can do giros comfortably in both directions and also know boleos, sacadas and ganchos.	Take all weekend and Monday workshops and benefit from the Advanced Pass or Superpass pricing.		

Prices, Discounts, Registration: Registering in advance gets you the lowest prices—just over \$9 per hour of instruction (for members in advance taking multiple workshops). The best value for intermediate and advanced dancers are the Weekend Pass and Advanced Pass or Superpass. Students get an additional 30% discount on top of this. See the attached registration form for full details and à la carte rates. To get the advance rate, please mail the attached registration form with your payment, postmarked by 10 June 2002 to: The Tango Society of Boston, Inc., P.O.
